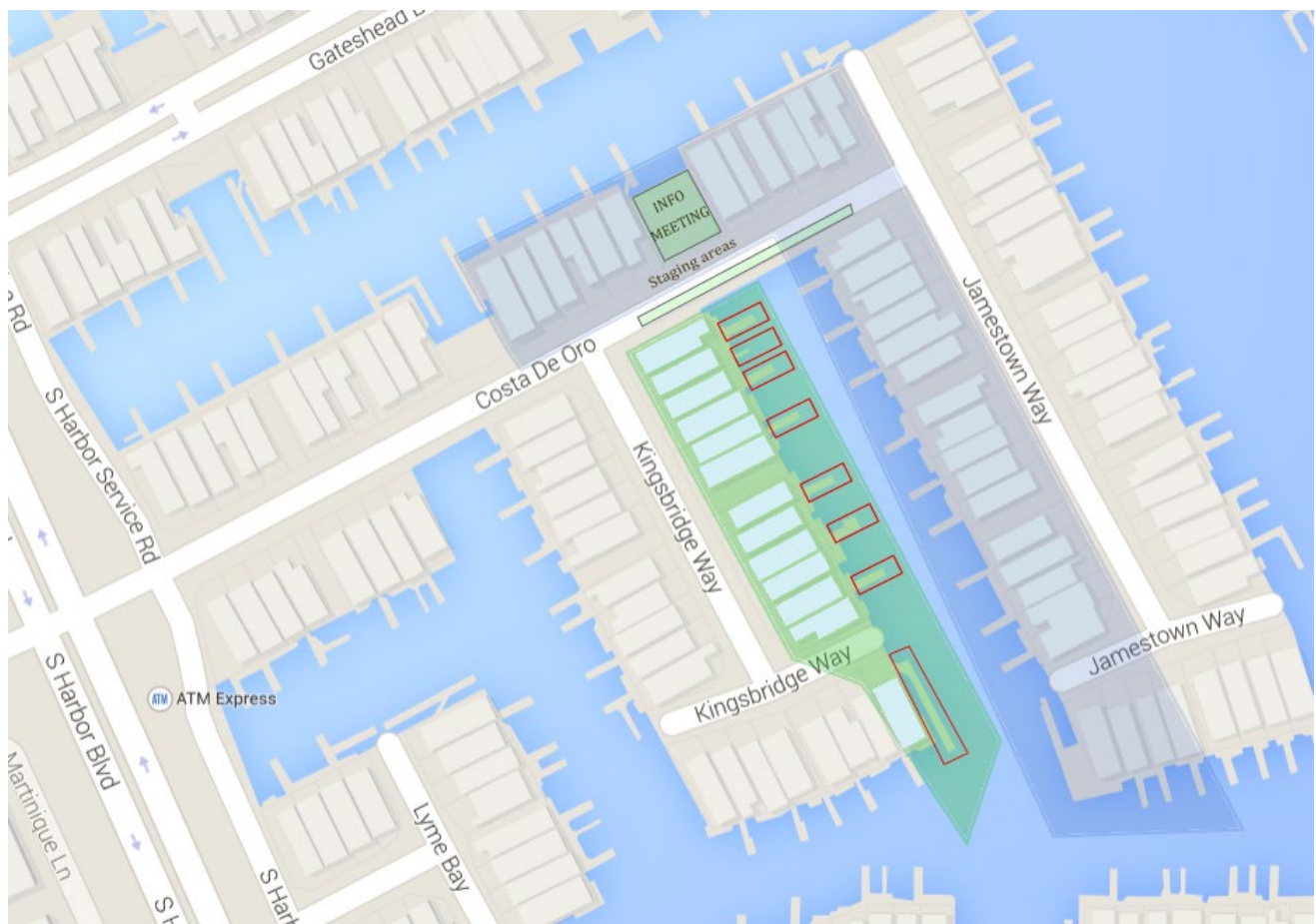
INFORMATION MEETING DATE: Saturday May 16th
