## **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

#### **Dear Homeowners**,

Due to the current pandemic, our annual Channel Islands Waterfront Homeowners meeting will be virtual. The meeting is scheduled for 9 am on Saturday, February 27th. We are still working on the particulars of the event. Please refer to our website (channelislandsca.com) for details and to access the meeting.

While surely it is an understatement to say that this has been a challenging year, we have made some significant progress as a homeowner's association.

On October 6th, the Oxnard City Council voted unanimously to agree to evenly divide the costs of the seawall repairs and replacement between the homeowners and the City of Oxnard. The members of the HOA have been working hard for over a decade to get the City to acknowledge that they own the seawalls, and that they have a financial obligation to restore and maintain them.

After years of verbal commitments, rescinded almost as frequently as made, this was a landmark decision. It is a vital step in laying the foundation of trust in establishing the public/private partnership for the funding of the repairs and replacement of our seawalls.

It is important to note that there will be no increase in your property taxes as a result of this agreement. Your property taxes can only be increased if the residents/homeowners vote to approve a new assessment district or funding mechanism to cover half the costs of the project.

The same night that the City Council agreed to the 50/50 split, they also approved funding from a federal grant, for a geotechnical study to gather the information required to determine the best strategy to repair the seawalls.

Once we have determined the best solution, we will work on determining the best funding mechanism. Only after these studies have been completed will we, as homeowners, consider a vote to increase our property taxes.

Channel Islands

The reason for the delayed date for our annual meeting is to provide the City an opportunity to review a report on the geotechnical study which they should receive in the second week of February.

In addition to the seawall agreement, we have made progress in repairing and restoring many of the pilasters supporting the seawalls on east side of Mandalay Bay. Harbour Constructors, in conjunction with department of Public Works, has nearly completed the replacement of 80 pilasters. This is the third phase of pilaster repairs. While we have made great progress in restoring many of the pilasters, there are still quite a few that need to be replaced.

Our landscape committee has been working diligently to get the City to remove the dead trees along Harbor boulevard. Now that the area has been cleared, the City is in the process of replacing the irrigation system and the trees to restore the barrier between Harbor boulevard and our community.

The Channel Islands Waterfront Homeowner's Association is a volunteer organization. While we are fortunate that many of our homeowners are willing to donate their time to help improve our community, we still need more help. Our committees need more volunteers. If there is an issue that is important to you, join us and together we can make a difference in our neighborhood.

# **2020 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES**

February 8, 2020

#### Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am by President Bill Clark who then led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Honored Guest:

District 1 Oxnard City Councilman Bert Perello was welcomed.

#### Seawall Project Update:

City Manager Alex Nguyen stated he understands our frustration with the lack of progress on this project. He then introduced Public Works Director Rosemarie Gaglione who made the presentation. Rosemarie gave a brief history of the seawalls and then described how they deteriorate. The long-awaited pilaster repair project is estimated to be completed in May, 2020. The alternative TetraTech sheet pile proposal is now estimated to cost \$200 million and assumes a 75-year design life.

#### Mayor Tim Flynn:

Mayor Flynn stated that the City is dealing with two projects about the same size as the seawalls. The City is presently in a positive financial position. The Fisherman's Wharf project will not go forward as presented.

#### District 1 Oxnard Councilman Perello:

Councilman Perello stated he will fight for us on the seawall project. However, the Council makes the decision. He stated that he felt the 25-year plan versus the 75-year plan is short-sighted.

#### Landscape Update:

Julie Phillips, Special Districts Manager, presented a report on landscaping activity. Monthly walkthroughs are being held with the contractor and HOA members. Maintenance of the Harbor Blvd. buffer area is complete and will continue through the greenbelts. The replanting of trees is in progress. Rehabilitation of the Kingsbridge greenbelt is complete.

#### Water Quality:

Chuck Carter presented the status of the water quality testing program. Extensive data are being collected. Volunteers are making the collections. The Water Board will pay for most of the laboratory costs. Surface Water Ambient Monitoring

Program (SWAMP) guidelines are being used to insure acceptable data. The goal is to meet Rec-1 water quality standards 95% of the time.

#### Cl Neighborhood Council:

Audrey Keller described the volunteer organization. She presented a list of current education and outreach activities.

#### Harbor & Beach Community Alliance:

Rene Aiu reported that the organization is fighting the appeal to the Coastal Commission regarding the Fisherman's Wharf project.

#### Closed Session for Members Only:

The Consent Agenda included: Minutes of the 2019 Annual Meeting, the 2019 Treasurer's Report and the 2020 Budget. All items of the Consent Agenda were approved.

#### Election of Board Members:

Reelected to fill their expired terms were Keith Beckwith, Mike Haase, Debbie Mitchell and Tom Shideler.

#### Review of the Meeting:

A discussion of "Pros, Cons and Solutions" regarding the meeting was held. Some of these items included:
