

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This year's annual homeowners meeting will be on Saturday, February 26th. We were looking forward to an in-person meeting this year, but unfortunately with the recent increase in cases it is more

prudent to again conduct the meeting via Zoom. Once we have set up the meeting, we will place

information on our website, and send out emails with instructions on how to log into the meeting.

The pandemic and the recent changes in leadership within the City, have delayed progress on repairs to our seawalls. The focus on two options for repairs- resurfacing and reinforcing the existing concrete, verses applying a new synthetic material over the surface of the walls and reinforcing it with additional tie backs. Both options have advantages and disadvantages.

Once we have more information regarding the synthetic material, both options will be presented to the homeowners.

While the seawall repairs are moving at a glacial pace, under the guidance of our landscape committee, in particular **Mike Haase**, we have made significant progress in renovating the landscaping along the western edge of our community.

In conjunction with the City, the department of public works has removed the dead trees, replaced the irrigation system, and planted new bushes along the length of Harbor Boulevard.

With time the new hedge should improve the separation between our members' homes and Harbor Boulevard.



We have replaced and updated the entrance signs at Meridian.

Although this has been a difficult year for many people, I really appreciate the hard work of our board members and those working on our committees.

As always, we are looking for homeowners interested in contributing back their community.

We have positions open on various committees.

If you are interested, please let us know, we can always use another enthusiastic individual.

2021 Annual Meeting Minutes 50/50 towards each.

February 27, 2021

Format of Meeting:

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the meeting was held via Zoom. Attendance was limited

to invited guests, homeowners and residents only. There were approximately 60 locations signed into the meeting.

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am by President Bill Clark who then led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honored Guests and Guest Speakers:

- Alex Nguyen, Oxnard City Manager
- Steve Howlett, Assistant Public Works Director
- Jeri Cooper, Manager, Special Assessment **Districts**
- Tatiana Arnaout, P.E. City Engineer

Alex Nguyen, Jeri Cooper and Tatiana Arnaout provided updates on the status of the Mandalay Bay seawall efforts. Their updates included:

Confirmation that the seawall repairs are on the list of the City's priority citywide projects.

City Council agreed that the repair costs will be funded by the City with a 50/50 split with homeowners.

City has submitted two FEMA Grant applications and is awaiting for notification from FEMA. Additional grant applications have also been submitted. Any grants obtained will count towards both the City's and Mandalay Bay's share of the costs, splitting

A repair analysis and geotechnical study have been completed. Detail structural plans are under development. Structural design is anticipated to be complete by yearend of 2021 with construction beginning in 2022.

There will be extensive community outreach to help ensure residents are well informed.

A Steering Committee will be created. Participants will include City representatives, Consultant(s) and residents of Mandalay Bay.

Closed Session:

At 9:45, City representatives were excused from the meeting for a members only closed session.

The 2020 Annual Meeting Minutes, Treasurers Report/Future Budget and Proposed Board Nominees Bill Clark, Alison Gabel, Chuck Carter and Connie Heagy were approved through Zoom.

Attendees submitted questions using Zoom Chat.

A poll was taken at the conclusion to determine attendee's opinions of the Meeting Quality of using Zoom. 88% of those that voted stated they thought Meeting Quality was "Just Right." 50% felt the Technical aspects of this venue were "Good" with approximately 8% indicating it was "Complicated." 6% felt that the meeting started "Too Early."

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30.
